

SEA LION SAFETY POLICY

We take the safety of the children very seriously and although many other swim schools in the area do not allow parents/guardians to enter onto poolside we do currently welcome you to watch from the spectator area. We do however, need **all** parents/guardians to adhere to our safety policy as per below (please ensure the that the person bringing your child/children is aware of this policy):

Beginner and Improver Parents/Guardians

One parent/guardian may stay with your child/children until the 2 minute whistle and then you need to take a seat in the spectator area.

Improver 1/2/3/4 and 5 parents/guardians

If you feel the need to walk your child/children to their bench, please do so, but once the two minute whistle is blown you need to take a seat in the spectator area.

Beginners and Imp 2 are collected by a member of the team and the other classes are sat in front of where they swim so parents/guardians do not need to deliver the children to the edge of the pool.

We are aware that some children (or parents!) are nervous, so if you do not feel able to leave them at the 2 minute whistle then please feel free to stand by the first set of blue doors as you come onto poolside. The poolside team will then take your child/children to their lesson as it starts.

The swimmers waiting area needs to be clear of parents / guardians at change over time – there are no exceptions.

Collecting your Child

We require <u>all</u> parents/guardians to wait by the changing room end of the pool to collect your child/children; please do not wait next to the class. Again no parents should be walking down the swimmers waiting side.

Fire Exit Route

We would like to remind parents/guardians not to stand in front of the glass windows or door as this is a fire exit route.

Toilets

Please ensure that your child/children are dry before entering the toilets.

Corridor

Please use the shoe rack for all shoes and do not leave any bags, clothing etc in the corridor – there are lockers available in the changing area.
